3. The following line styles listed in the key should aid in keeping track of the sources and weight to be placed on its value.

Names Data supported member

- Data have hard copy
 - 1) Must list source and be a very good fit. Do not treat as a fact yet.
 - 2) Will have extract from actual document when possible.
 - 3) Note: The sloped style, used when info approaches fact.
- ω WEH_1988 Source
 - 1) Extracted from the 1988 book and addenda, have not yet found the material the sources quoted.
- Data possible/ or need hard copy
 - 1) Info I have come across, with source that may or may not be of value.
- Comment
 - 1) Speculation, possible problems with existing information or just a note to the reader.

- 4. The Head of House and all their children will be displayed in this section: proven or not.
 - a. Treat each person as a detailed chapter in a book, father, mother and children. I have found the abbreviated source format widely used to be unclear and difficult to reconstruct.
 - i. Note: No detail of child that is next Head of House in our family tree will be entered on the parents page. A comment directing you to see next Head of House for details will be used.
 - b. **Any data** found for an individual is to be entered in that persons section. If a fact covers 4 people it should be listed with each of the (4 persons).
 - c. If a member is disprove his name will not be removed from that family, a note will be entered as to where that person has been placed including all the date to support that move.
- 5. Any type of info listed under the **KEY** will be upgraded to the style (• *Data*) when verified (Hard copy obtained).
- 6. Hope to add (♦ Fact) to the **Key** a line to replace the Date () this will be used when 2 or more data items support each other.
- 7. Grand-children
 - a. A list showing their name, date of birth, and their wife's will be displayed with Head of House.
 - b. No supporting data will be added, This is only for reference.
 - c. All supporting data or comments will be found on the Head of House page set up for their parents.
