Giant and Notre Dame Famed Scout

Jack Lavelle Reports

Scouting helps to simplify preparation for future opponents. Without scouting you would be faced with the task of rehearsing your team through many valuable hours against every possible type of offense and defense.

Nearly everyone wants to know where a scout prefers to operate, that is, where does he locate himself at a game. Most scouts like to sit high up in the press box, near the center of the field. Occasionally, you may take a seat behind the goal posts in the upper stand. This helps you to get a good idea of the opponent's line spacing, both on offense and defense. From there, you will also view the game from a different angle and will get the inter-relation of the linemen when they go through their various maneuvers.

DUTIES OF THE SCOUT

Scouts generally prefer to work alone as they have certain definite things which they are going to look for, from a particular opponent. They usually use a system of free hand notes which they put down when the ball is out of bounds or during a time out period. While the ball is in play, the scout pays strict attention to the action on the field. Many scouts remember with regret the fact that early in their career they were writing down some unimportant detail, while a back was going 50 yards for the game's only score.

SIZING UP THE PARK

You usually like to get to your location about an hour before so as to observe any things peculiar to the park in which the game is being played and to familiarize yourself with the actions of the players on the team that you are scouting.

You note the passers, kickers, speed of certain men, line interferers, kick off and place kicking specialists, in this pre-game workout. At this time you can compare the players as to size, weight and speed. If some men are reported to be injured you can check on it at this time.

Regarding your future opponent's offense you should check on the various offensive formations from which they operate and the type of plays they use from each of these formations. You try to strike a balance regarding the strength or weakness of their various plays. You also check on the blocking patterns they use on their various offensive maneuvers. As closely as you can begin, early in the game, to try to form an opinion of the offensive ability of the various players.

OBSERVING THE SUBS

When substitutes replace them, you should note their performance so as to determine whether your opponent's substitutions will weaken them in any way. When the third and fourth quarters are under way you can be checking your earlier estimates of the various players abilities.

Naturally, their pass offense will be a very important item to report on. Types of passes, favorite receivers and protection for the passer should be carefully observed.

Regarding the overall picture of the game, the strategy of the signal caller will come in for a lot of attention. The plays called by him in the various areas of the gridiron, against certain types of defense, may help to give you an idea as to what he might call in a similar situation against us. Then, too, we can see what type of defense may be calculated to give his offense some trouble, so a careful look at their opponent's defense may be of great help to us.

DEFENSE IMPORTANCE

One of the most interesting and important phases of the game is the type of defense used by our future opponents. Most coaches will agree that they spend considerable time operating their offense against many defensive setups. You have seen many great teams stopped by over-shifted lines which were designed to stop great running teams with no weak side attack. Giant fans will recall the outstanding five man defensive lines which Steve Owen has done so much to popularize. To begin to describe the many defensive setups would exhaust the capacity of this book.

The familiar defenses are the 5-3-2-1, the 6-2-2-1, the 6-3-2 and the 7-1-2-1. The backfield pass defense may be of a zone type, in which each man has a certain area to cover. Or it may resolve itself into a man to man system of coverage, where each backfield man has a certain individual assigned to his custody. Finally, some teams will use a combination of both, some men covering certain individuals while others cover definite areas. To find out what method of coverage is being used and in what area of the field they will use this, is the question that ages most scouts much quicker than even the income tax.

CHRONOLOGY OF NFL

Compiled by Ray Byrne

(Concluded from November 9th)

1946 Cleveland Rams franchise transferred by league permission to Los Angeles (January 12).

Bert Bell, Steeler President, appointed Commissioner, replacing Elmer Layden on January 11.

Open pilfering of players from NFL from newly organized All-America Conference and vice-versa.

Daniel Topping, owner of Brooklyn franchise transferred affiliation to New York Yankees of the AAC. Players of Brooklyn wishing to remain in NFL transferred to Boston Yanks (December 17, 1945).

Championship playoff game at New York, December 15, won by Chicago Bears, 24-14.

'Black Sox Football Scandal' broke before game when apparent 'fix' of two key Giant players, Merle Hapes and Frank Filchok uncovered by alert N.Y. newsman Hapes forbidden to play in game. Both suspended.

1947 Merle Hapes and Frank Filchok subsequently indefinitely suspended from National League, and finally (April 4, 1947) barred from league.

Adoption of league rule limiting league to ten teams (January 11). Substitutions limited to no more than three men at one time. Receiving team permitted to run punts and unsuccessful field goal attempts out from behind goal line. Forward passes automatically incomplete on striking either team's goal posts. (All previous rules adopted January 11.) National League entered agreement for three years with American Association (later renamed American League), Dixie League and Pacific Coast League (January 13).

Latrobe, Pa., officially recognized by National League as birthplace of Professional Football. Memorial to be erected at site of first pro game, August 31, 1895. Ratified July 20.
