Giants in First Kezar Appearance

This is a red-letter day for both the San Francisco 49ers and the New York Giants. Today marks the first appearance of the Giants in our town for a football game in all their 30-year history. It also inaugurates the first of six exhibition games for the 49ers against National Football League rivals this season.

Coach Buck Shaw's team warmed up for this one against Fort Ord last Sunday with an easy 42-14 victory while the Giants, under new coach Jim Lee Howell, ran into more than they could handle and dropped a 30-7 decision to the powerful Los Angeles Rams.

Despite the setback against the Rams, again rated one of the top contenders for the Western Conference championship, the Giants are not to be kissed off lightly. They were expected to start slowly and will gain momentum under the coaching reigns of Howell, successor to Steve Owen, who held the job lock, stock and barrel for 23 years.

Howell is a Giant in size and history. He towers 6-feet-4 and brings to his job an intimate knowledge of the National Football League dating back to 1937, when he joined the Giants as a star end. Howell's football background combines a native fondness for attack, rather than defense as expounded by the portly Owen.

Pleased though he may be with the great array of running backs on the Giant squad, Howell tells one and all: "Remember I come from Arkansas where we like to throw the ball around." Howell learned his football in the "aerial circus" days in the mid-Thirties in the Southwest Conference. His own Arkansas team as well as Sammy Baugh and Company of Texas Christian proved at that time the forward pass was here to stay.

The Giants, like the 49ers, believe they have one of the great backfields of all-time — an All-American group of not four men, but six, with three running stars and the pick of three peerless quarterbacks. Coach Shaw, the Silver

Fox of Menlo, will probably look with jaundiced eye on the quarterbacks. He could use at least one of the three as a backstop for Y. A. Tittle.

(Memo to Shaw: Well, Buck, why not make a quick trade before these Giants leave town?).

Arrayed against the 49ers today will be halfbacks Kyle Rote and Frank Gifford, Fullback Eddie Price and Quarterbacks Charley Conerly, Arnold Galiffa and Don Heinrich. The names Gifford and Heinrich will ring a bell with Pacific Coast football fans. Gifford starred at USC and Heinrich at the University of Washington.

The two are among six former Coast Conference stars on the Giant roster. The others are Halfback Wayne Berry of Washington State, Guard Bill Austin of Oregon State, and Ends Dick Wilkins of Oregon and Cliff Livingston of UCLA. Austin was stationed for a time at the Presidio here while in the service.

I doubt that any 49er fan would agree to a swap of any of the talented stars now performing for San Francisco. When you talk about great backfields, the 49ers believe they have one with Tittle, Joe (Jet) Perry, Hugh McElhenny and Joe Arenas or John Henry Johnson. And you can also include fellows like Pete Schabarum, Jim Monachino and Billy Mixon as other handy guys to have around.


The Giants have plenty of big men down front on both offense and defense to match the 49ers' Bob St. Clair, Leo Nomellini, Al Carapella, Doug Hogland and rookie Marion Campbell as well as others of similar size and stature. Howell can call upon tackles like Earl Putnam (300), Joe Springer (280) and Billy Shipp (275). If that isn't a beef trust, it will do for the present.

This could be quite a football game today, with passing by Tittle and Conerly predominating. The 49ers will have to penetrate the famed "Umbrella Defense" originated by Steve Owen and still coached by Howell.
