DETROIT LIONS vs. NEW YORK GIANTS

World Champion Giants Give Lions Real Test

If 'Our Boys' Can Take 'Em, They're Set For The Rest

Coach Jim Lee Howell brings his World Champion New York Giants into Briggs Stadium today to face the Detroit Lions in the final pre-season encounter of the year for both clubs.

The regular 1957 National Football League campaign gets underway next week with a full schedule of games.

Both teams have identical records, three victories and two losses, coming into the game. The Giants bested the College All-Stars, 22-12, downed the Los Angeles Rams, 24-7, and beat the Chicago Bears, 24-17, while losing to San Francisco, 24-15, and dropping a 13-10 decision to the Green Bay Packer.s

Detroit, meanwhile, scored three straight early season victories over Cleveland, 20-10, Philadelphia, 34-27, and Washington, 31-14, before suffering successive losses at the hands of the Pittsburgh Steelers, 20-14, and Cleveland, 23-7.

Today's meeting figures to be primarily a meeting between two clubs made up primarily of veteran performers. Thirty-four veterans are listed on the Giants roster, thirty-one of whom played major roles in the 47-7 decision over the Chicago Bears in the title game last December. Three others were with the team prior to last year's championship effort.

This afternoon's game marks the first game in two years between the Lions and the Giants. Detroit de-

feated New York, 27-17, in a pre-season encounter before the 1955 season but later in the season's finale the Giants turned the tables with a 24-19 verdict.

A lot of pro experts rate the Giants starting backfield of Chuck Conerly or Don Heinrich at quarterback, Frank Gifford and Alex Webster at halfbacks, and Mel Triplett as the finest all-around offensive backfield in the National Football League. Gifford, the former Southern California star, was named Player of the Year in the league last year after leading the Giants to their first title since 1938.

One of the top newcomers with the Giants is half-back Dennis (The Menace) Mendyck of Michigan State. Mendyck is the property of the Detroit Tigers and is considered a great baseball prospect as well as a topnotch gridster. End Bob Topp of Michigan is another Michigan product. He returns after a service hitch.

Coach George Wilson still finds his club short-handed on his right hand, Sonny Gandee is sidelined with a damaged knee, and Jim Doran and Leon Hart can't shake leg injuries that have hampered them in recent weeks.

This is the only scheduled meeting of the season between the two teams but both coaches hope the league race works out so that there is a rematch here later this season . . . in the 1957 NFL championship playoff.
